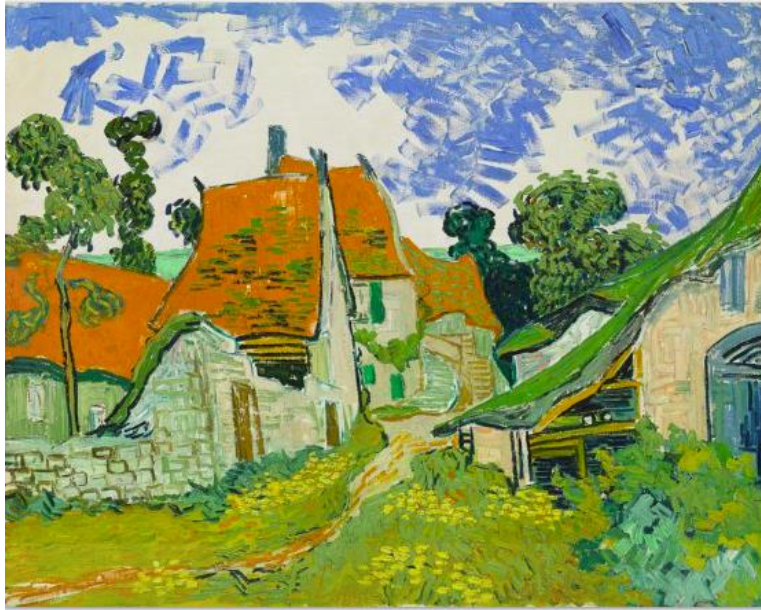

Finnish National Gallery: Art Collection about 40 000 art works

- Sinebrychoff Art Museum: old international art from the 14th to the early 19th century
- Ateneum Art Museum: Finnish art up to 1960s and international art from the 19th and 20th centuries
- Museum of Contemporary Art Kiasma: Finnish and international art from 1960s onwards



Browse, search and find information on the works, artists and collections of the Ateneum Art Museum, the Museum of Contemporary Art Kiasma and the Sinebrychoff Art Museum.

The Finnish National Gallery has freed nearly 12 000 images licensed with the CC0 licence. Images marked  can be freely used by anyone. They can be shared, modified and used in any context, including teaching, research, and commercial purposes, for example. These images are free to be used because the copyright (70 full calendar years after the death of the artist) has expired.

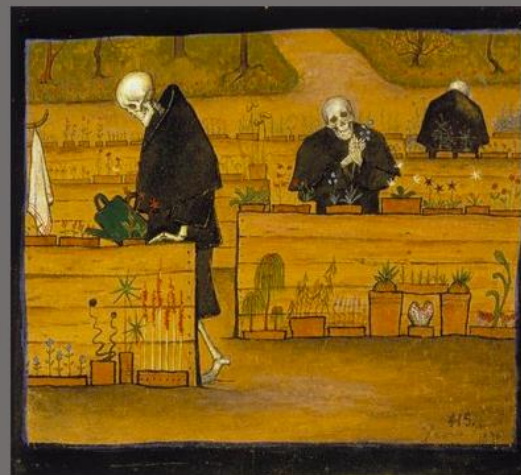
