



Megastar – Shaped by you



- When you transport 4,7 million people a year from Helsinki to Tallinn and back, you learn how to build a custom-made new ship called Megastar.
- Megastar is built in Meyer Turku (Finland) shipyard.
- Megastar can accommodate altogether
 2800 passengers (+40 % than current vessels) and there are 3800 lanemeters (+60 %)
- Megastar will be 212 meters long and gross tonnage of 49 000 and service speed of 27 knots
- Investment of 230 M €



Megastar's godmother is President Tarja Halonen

- Environmental aspects made President Tarja Halonen agree to become the Megastar's godmother.
- "Megastar was created with sustainable development in mind, and represents a new wave of ecological thinking", says Tarja Halonen.





Wärtsilä manufactured the LNG engines for the Megastar

- Using natural gas LNG as fuel will reduce noise and exhaust gas emissions.
- Dual-fuel engines in LNG mode produce:
 - 25% less CO2,
 - 85% less NOx and
 - practically zero SOx and particles, compared to traditional diesel or heavy-fuel burning engines.
- Ship's hull has been designed exclusively for Megastar.







- Boarding and disembarking will be very convenient.






New automooring system Moor Master
