

SUOMENLINNA FORTRESS: Boundary line and buffer-zone

Open sea and the islands close to Suomenlinna fortress form - with the southern parts of the city of Helsinki - the buffer-zone around the fortress. The islands surrounding Suomenlinna are either recreational areas owned by the City of Helsinki, military area owned by the state or uninhabited rocky islets.

Buffer-zone is indicated with colours on two basic maps (1:20 000), Helsinki (2034 06) and Isosaari (2034 05) to the south.

Military area: coast artillery garrisons and forts.

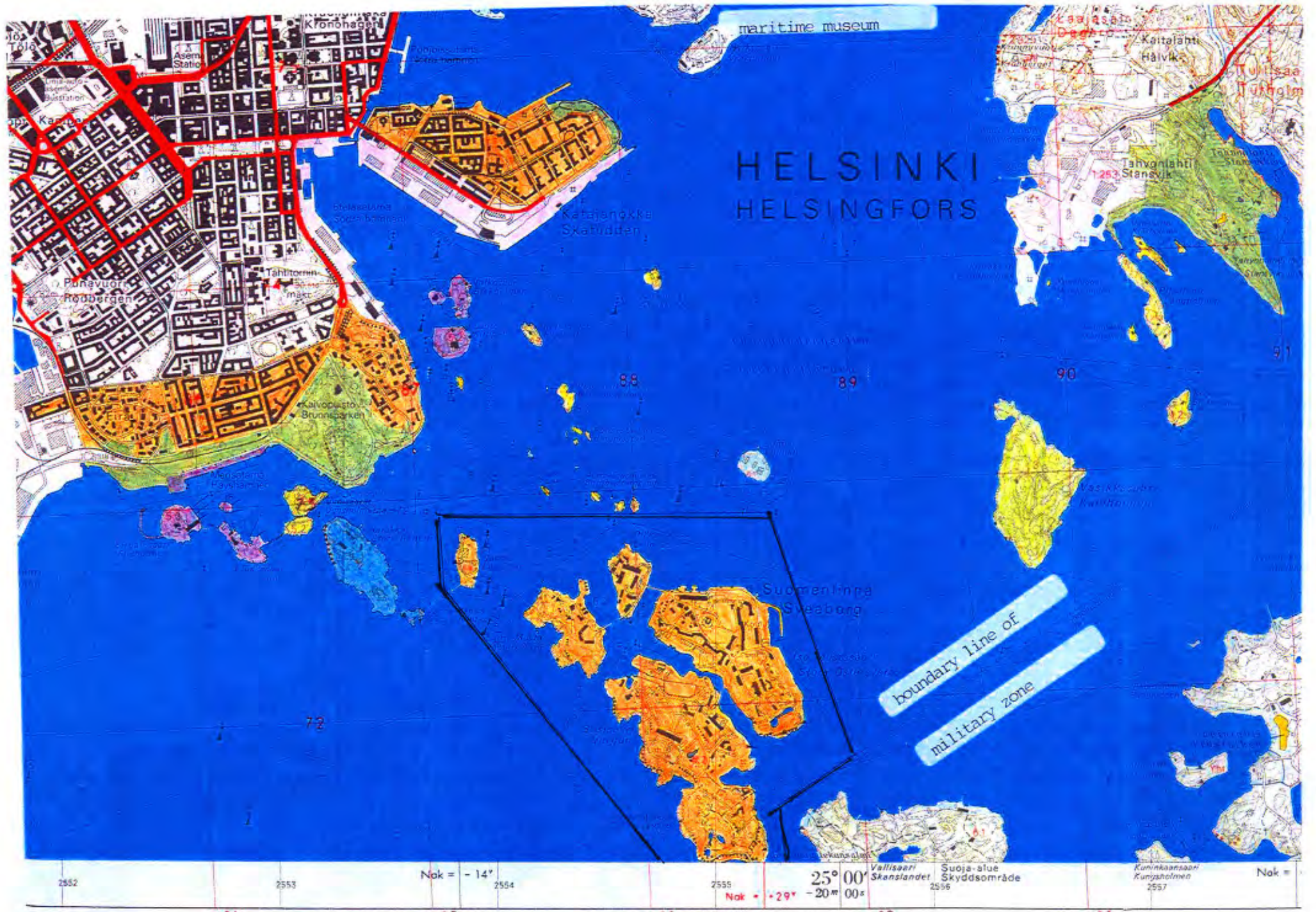

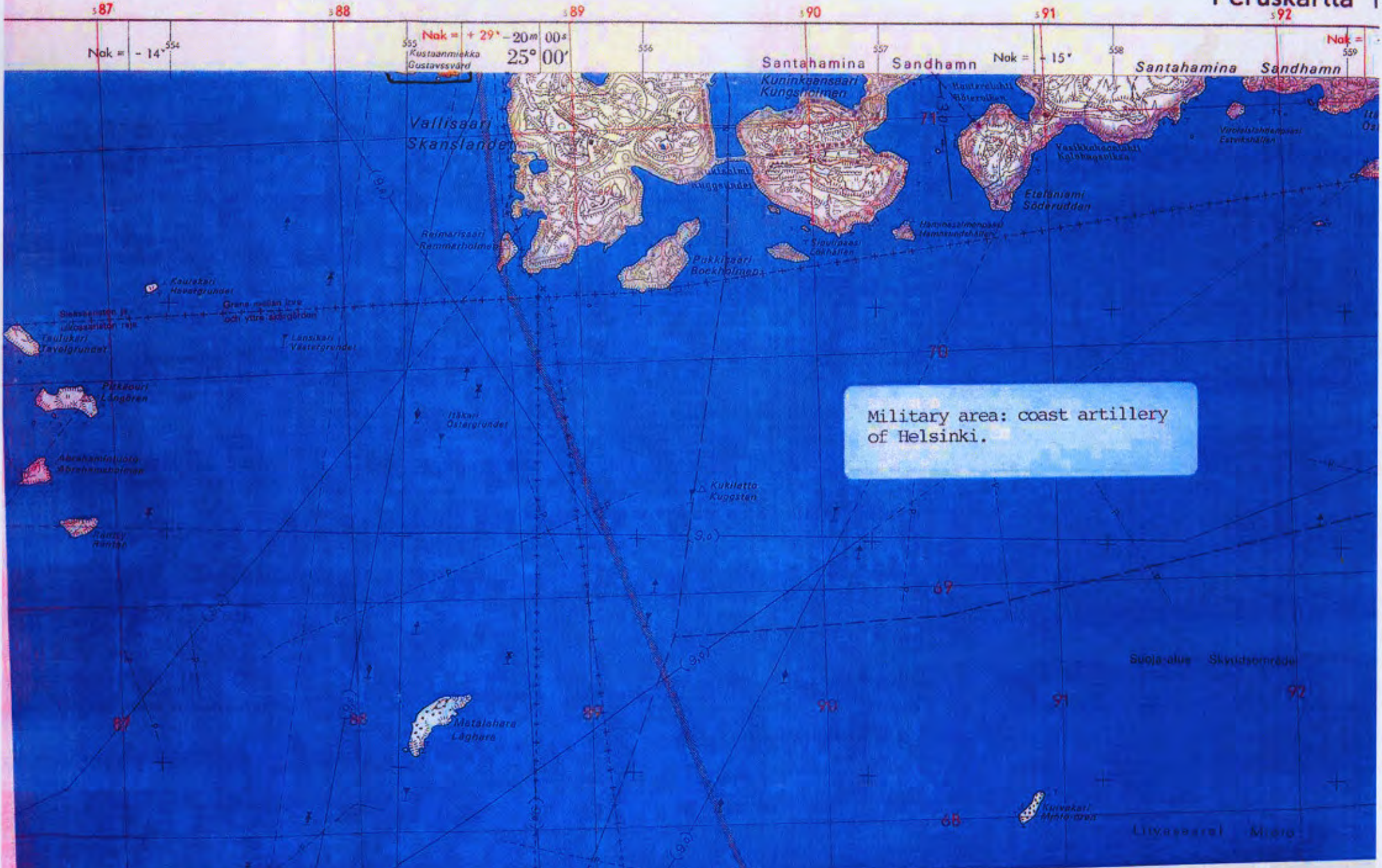
