



The highest recorded temperature in 2023 was 28.1°C (August 7) and lowest –12.2°C (March 9).
























Greenhouse emissions

The emissions of greenhouse gases have been cut down by 25% since 1990 in Helsinki.





City of Helsinki expenses by division (2023)




Municipal tax rate*
