



Recovery rates on the increase, extraction of resources grows faster



Value hill: importance of value retention






INTRODUCING THE NETHERLANDS

- With limited space & natural resources it makes sense to collaborate and find local, scalable solutions to close resource cycles







TAKE AWAYS


- Circular Economy is happening today




ROADMAP CITY OF AMSTERDAM

Lack of venture capital in circular projects


Restrictive / non-supportive policy



Barriers


No real regulatory barriers but action is not happening
