



Confidentiality commitments for research team members when applying for a research permit

I commit to not disclosing the research materials I receive or revealing any confidential information used in the research to third parties. The aforementioned commitment means I have a duty of confidentiality and non-disclosure regarding the information I obtain through the research.

I commit to complying with the applicable legislation, particularly the requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act regarding the processing of personal data, as well as taking responsibility for the lawful handling of the data.

I commit to promptly notifying the Education Division research permit service if I become aware of a data security breach involving the personal data related to the research.

I commit to following the instructions provided by the research permit issuer regarding the collection and processing of the data.

All individuals who handle confidential documents or data from personal registers must provide a commitment either on this form or as a separate attachment with the same content. Electronic signature is permitted.
