*) Compulsory Education Act, section 2: Children permanently residing in Finland shall attend compulsory schooling. Compulsory schooling shall start in the year during which the child turns seven years of age, at the beginning of the school year defined in the Basic Education Act (628/1998). Compulsory education shall end when the pupil turns 18 years of age or when the pupil has completed a matriculation examination as defined in the Act on the Matriculation Examination (502/2019) or qualification as defined in the Act on Vocational Education and Training (531/2017), or an equivalent qualification completed in Åland or similar education provided abroad.

Compulsory Education Act, section 9: The parent/carer of a pupil in compulsory education shall see to it that pupil's compulsory schooling is completed.

Basic Education Act, section 26: A child of compulsory school age must attend comprehensive education provided in accordance with the Basic Education Act or otherwise obtain knowledge corresponding to the comprehensive education syllabus. The completion of comprehensive education shall end when the comprehensive education syllabus has been completed or, at the latest, by the end of the school year's school work in the calendar year during which the pupil turns 17 years of age.
