This notification will remain valid until further notice. The guardian must notify the basic education services of the Education Division if the student is removed from home schooling or if the supervisory teacher changes.

*) Section 25: Children permanently residing in Finland shall attend compulsory schooling. Compulsory schooling shall start in the year during which the child turns seven. Compulsory schooling shall end when the basic education syllabus has been completed or ten years after the beginning of compulsory schooling.

Section 26: A child of compulsory school age must attend basic education provided in accordance with this Act or otherwise obtain knowledge corresponding to the basic education syllabus. The parent/carer of a pupil in compulsory education shall see to it that compulsory schooling is completed.
