## Activities for families with babies and small children will also be organised indoors at playgrounds and family houses from 13 September

Instructed group activities for families with babies and small children have been organised as outdoor activities at playgrounds since 1 September 2021. Family house activities have not been organised.

- From 13 September 2021, open early childhood education group activities for families with babies and small children will also be organised indoors at playgrounds and family houses. You must register in advance for the groups, and the number of participants will be limited if necessary. You can find the guidelines for registration on the playground or family house website or you can get them by phone.
- Toilets and handwashing facilities are available. The indoor areas of playgrounds and family houses are reserved for group activities only: clubs, activities for families with babies and small children, and after-school activities for schoolchildren.
- Children and families can use the outdoor areas, fixed play equipment and yard toys at playgrounds.
- The activities follow the current coronavirus guidelines, and the staff provides guidance in health safety. We recommend you to wear a facemask indoors.

Please only come to the playground and family house if you are healthy, and follow the safety and hygiene signs. Wear a facemask as recommended, keep a safe distance and wash your hands.

The outdoor areas of playgrounds offer many activities, including changing play equipment and themes. The child and accompanying adult can play together safely. Please keep a safe distance from others when playing.
