## **4. Purposes of the processing of personal data and the legal grounds for the processing**

### **Purposes of and legal basis for processing**

The purpose of the data file is to organise events for groups and to provide information and communication related to the organisation of events. The data is processed for signing up for cultural events and for contact. The data file indicates who are using the service.

For unregistered users (event participants), the legal basis is Article 6(1)(a) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation: The data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.

For registered users (event organisers), the legal basis is Article 6 (1)(b) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation: Performance of a contract to which the data subject is one of the parties.

## **5. Data content of the register**

Registered user (event organiser): name, telephone number, email address, organisation, event venue, language, email address for contact.

Unregistered user (event participant): name, telephone number, email address, name of entered group, size, grade level, name of entered group's school or day-care centre or educational institution, notification language.

## **6. Regular disclosures of personal data**

No data disclosures, including outside the EU or EEA. Anonymous disclosures for statistical purposes.

## **7. Data storage periods**

The personal data in the register are retained for 24 months after the last use. Personal data are retained especially for the purpose of long-term statistical follow-up. The personal data processed for analytical and statistical purposes will be anonymised (rendering personal data unidentifiable) and deleted in such a way that the data can no longer be considered personal data.

The data subject may delete, rectify and view his or her personal data upon request.

## **8. Sources of personal data**

Personal data is obtained from the data subjects themselves.
