Kasin katutyöt – street works to begin on Caloniuksenkatu, Runeberginkatu and Helsinginkatu on 11 January 2021

We will begin extensive renovation work in Töölö and Kallio on Caloniuksenkatu, Runeberginkatu and Helsinginkatu in 2021. The project is estimated to be completed at the end of 2022. The project has been named Kasin katutyöt.

The upgrades will make tram route No 8 faster and increase the safety and comfort of walking and cycling. The pipes and cables that run underground will also be replaced as part of the project.

In January 2021, work will begin on

- Caloniuksenkatu
- Helsinginkatu next to Brahenkenttä, and Kaarlenkatu.

The street works on Caloniuksenkatu and Kaarlenkatu will begin with the replacement of water management elements. Work will initially be carried out on one side of these street over a section of a few dozen metres. The project will progress section by section until spring, at which point the worksite will be expanded.

In spring:

- Runeberginkatu (from Mannerheimintie to Töölöntori)
- Ruusulankatu (from Runeberginkatu to Sibeliuksenkatu)
- Läntinen Brahenkatu.

The worksite will affect traffic

The work will have a significant impact on traffic in the area. Initially, the trams will run as normal. Pedestrians, cyclists and cars will also be able to use all the streets. Access to properties by occupants, maintenance and emergency vehicles as well as deliveries will be arranged with ramps, if necessary. Some of the parking space will no longer be available when the work begins.

Notifications of new tram transport arrangements taking place in spring will be issued well in advance.

Follow the progress

The worksite schedules and information about the daily working hours and any night-time work will be published as soon as they have been confirmed.
