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Who may apply?

1. All pupils who speak a language other than Finnish or Swedish as their mother tongue or at home may study their own native language or some other language used in their family.
2. Romani pupils.
3. Sámi pupils.
4. Finnish pupils, who have learnt a foreign language while living abroad, may receive instruction in this language to retain their skills, on the presumption that the language is not the language of instruction at their own school.

The lessons are complementary to basic education and are organised during the school day, but not at the same time with lessons compulsory to all.

Two hours of instruction are provided each week.

Lessons are not necessarily given at a pupil's own school but at some other school, in which case the guardian may apply for a free school journey ticket for these trips.

A pupil may apply for only one native language group at a time.
